TOTAL SALE: 55 Bulls averaged \$4,786

This sale average was considerably better than last year's average. It is just short of \$700 higher than the previous year. The consignors keep moving the quality bar a little higher each year. The buyers continue to like our Wisconsin bull development program and the bulls that the consignors bring to our test.

One other significant thing that happened on this day was that Wisconsin Beef Improvement Association recognized Darlington Farms for their loyalty to the Wisconsin Bull test. They have attended each and every sale since our very first sale in Hancock, Wisconsin in 1957. Either Homer Evenstad or someone from Darlington Farms has attended one of our 67 sales since then. Specific Breed Information:

The two top selling bulls each sold for \$7,000. Simmental, Lot # 12, a KBHR Bold Ruler son was purchased by Gill Brothers, Shullsburg, WI. This bull was consigned by Double A Simmental Farm in Janesville, WI. The Allan Arndt Family are the people behind the Double A Simmental Farm.

The second \$7,000 bull sold came from Shawano, Wisconsin. Johnson Family Cattle Co. were the proud sellers of this bull, Lot # 53. David and Karen Gallion are the proud new owners of this Red Angus sire, a son of Bieber CL Atomic C218. His new home is now Spencer, Wisconsin.

The two next high selling bulls were a Charolais bull and an Angus bull. They each sold for \$6,750. The Charolais bull was consigned by Jake and Regan Adams, from Cedar Rapids, Iowa.
